



Lubbock County Population Characteristics











Home Price Index – Lubbock MSA




Average Annual Wages



Texas Housing Affordability





GDP (Gross Domestic Product): the total value of goods produced and services provided by Lubbock




GDP Per Capita





Job Growth by Industry





Without tourism, each household in Lubbock would need to spend an additional \$9,246.26 ANNUALLY in local establishments










Water Future Water Supply – Lake 7 ready in 2032
